This morning we received via email notice from Government of Delhi De-recognising our school w.e.f 1st April 2019. They further instructed that no fresh admissions to be taken. This information was made available to media almost a week ago and like many of you, we were greatly shocked and disappointed after reading the newspaper headlines.

The main reason cited for de-recognising our school was the fee fixed for academic year 2016-17. This caused some parents to complain to the department against the school and so in the Directorate's words "In the larger interest of parents and students the school has been de-recognised."

In Mount Carmel School we have always, and will continue to, respect the dedication and contribution of the teachers on whom the responsibility of nation building rests. Mount Carmel was the first school to release 7th CPC to its staff and implement the same, including payment of arrears in the year 2016. The entire amount raised was utilised for the same
